Hebrews 10:25 (NIV)

(25) not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

Proverbs 12:25 (NIV)

(25) Anxiety weighs down the heart, but a kind word cheers it up.

Ephesians 4:29 (NIV)

(29) Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.

Acts 4:36 (NIV)

(36) Joseph, a Levite from Cyprus, whom the apostles called Barnabas (which means "son of encouragement"),

Application
