1 Thessalonians 5:16 (NIV)

(16) Rejoice always,

says, "Be joyful always". How is joy different to happiness?

Philippians 4:4 (NIV)

(4) Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!

Habakkuk 3:17-18, 2 Corinthians 6:10

Habakkuk 3:17-18 (NIV)

- (17) Though the fig tree does not bud and there are no grapes on the vines, though the olive crop fails and the fields produce no food, though there are no sheep in the pen and no cattle in the stalls,
- (18) yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will be joyful in God my Savior.

2 Corinthians 6:10 (NIV)

(10) sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; poor, yet making many rich; having nothing, and yet possessing everything.

James 1:2-4 (NIV)

- (2) Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds,
- (3) because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance.

Galatians 5:22 (NIV)

(22) But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

Philippians 4:4 (NIV)

(4) Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!
